The information below outlines the minimum requirements and other relevant information regarding mobile device sourcing for parents.

Chromebooks

All Chromebook purchases for a student in any year group should be made through the [St Stanislaus' BYODD Portal](#). This is the mandated purchase method for Years 7, 8, & 9. Chromebooks can be purchased anywhere under the BYOD policy for Years 10, 11, & 12.

The devices available on the Portal have been designed to provide your son with the best learning experience possible and as such, this is where we recommend you purchase your device from. The Parent Portal also has accessories, insurance, and payment plans on offer to make the process easy and flexible.

All Other Mobile Devices

BYODD iPads or BYOD mobile technology may be purchased wherever the parent/guardian would like to do so providing the minimum specifications outlined below are adhered to.

Battery Life	8 hour battery life regardless of device

Hardware Features	Camera & Microphone: These are necessary to ensure students can participate in 21st-century learning activities.

Label	Each BYO Device should be labeled with the student's name.
