These scholarships will be awarded to students who are deemed to have the academic potential, the personal qualities and the abilities to thrive at Stannies and to make a positive contribution to the life of the College.

Academic Scholarship

 - Engagement and success in inter-school or other representative competitions across a variety of KLAs
 - College Literacy/Numeracy Test.

- Academic Results of a high standard

- Awards in the Creative Arts field
- Levels of study in the Creative Arts (eg high AMEB grades)
- Competition success in the Creative Arts
- Primary school participation/representation in the Creative Arts
- Creative Arts focus of the College for 2020/2021.

All Rounder Scholarship

- Academic results of a high standard
- School Reports that reflect effort and achievement
- A record of a balanced range of achievements across a variety of pursuits
- Active participation in and contribution to a broad range of primary school co-curricular activities
- Representative experience at school, local and higher levels
- Leadership experience (eg SRC, sporting teams)
- Participation in a broad range of out of school activities/competitions.

NB: The College does not participate in ACER testing as part of the scholarship process. Year 7 Scholarship applicants will be required to sit a College Literacy and Numeracy test on Wednesday, 18 February 2019 at 9am at the College in the Performing Arts Centre. Alternate arrangements can be made for students who are unable to sit the Scholarship test on this date or who reside beyond the Bathurst region.

The continuation of the two-year scholarship will be contingent upon the following expectations:

- i. Continued strong academic effort and achievement,
- ii. Ongoing, committed participation in and contribution to all aspects of College life,
- iii. Ongoing support of all College expectations.

- ii. Fees and other monies owing to the College are paid promptly.

There will be a review of the academic progress and contribution to College life of all Scholarship holders in Term 3 of the first year of the Scholarship to ensure that expectations are being met. Scholarship holders in Year 7 2020 will be eligible to apply for a further two year Scholarship in Term 3, 2021 following the established application procedures.
